

Call for North Intensive Programme (NIP) Belgium: 22-30 March 2025

Mwenge Catholic University (MWECAU) and Erasmus Brussels University of Applied Sciences and Arts (EhB) in Brussels, Belgium are organizing a joint interdisciplinary international workshop in the framework of the Flemish Interuniversity Council (VLIR-UOS) Global Minds North Intensive Programme (NIP) of Belgium. The International workshop is scheduled for 22-30 March 2025 and will involve students from Erasmus Brussels University of Applied Sciences and Arts (EhB) and Mwenge Catholic University (MWECAU). The title of the workshop is Multidisciplinary Analysis of Brussels Cityscape. Ten students and two academic staff from MWECAU are expected to join the students and staff in this workshop.

MWECAU Students Eligibility

- Be a second or third year student studying BSc in Computer Science
- Be a second or third year student studying BA in Geography and Environmental Studies
- Must have a good progressive academic Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.5 and above
- Must have valid travel document i.e. Passport
- Be able to use Q-GIS software, Auto CARD and Adobe Photoshop or related software
- Possess basic Graphic Design and photograph skills
- Have a good command of both writing and speaking the English language
- Demonstrate leadership, management and personal organization skills
- Have good health to perform activities during the program
- Have a passion for working in the field under varied conditions
- Be ready to undertake Field Practical Training for five weeks in our Living Lab at MWECAU in March 2025.

Available positions for programme participation

- Bachelor of Science in Computer Science: 4 positions (Second and Third year students)
- Bachelor of Arts in Geography and Environmental Studies: Six (6) positions (Second year four (4) students & Third year two (2) students).

Note that gender balance will be strongly considered

Mode of recruitment and selection

Prospective participants should apply by writing one (1) page motivation and personal statement to the following email: gileard.minja@mwecau.ac.tz. Evaluation will be done by a special committee and the shortlisted candidate will be called for an oral and practical interview. The final 10 selected students will be invited for an information session on how they will participate in the programme (the Field Practical Training for five weeks in the Living Lab at MWECAU and the joint workshop in Brussels) including Visa application.
